Employer Proposal

The Employer presented a proposal to resolve a number of issues currently before the CAIACC which included:

- A shift pattern for the afternoon shift at VDC.
- The elimination of a work schedule change at KDC.
- Applying approved store schedule templates to stores where no agreement could be reached on store work schedules. A commitment to finalize work schedules by June 30, 2004.

A discussion was held regarding the proposal. The BCGEU was not in agreement with the terms of the Employer's offer.

The parties agreed to enter into mediation sessions to resolve the Hours of Work issues at VDC/KDC and Stores. The sessions were arranged for May 17, 20 and 21, 2004. As a result of the decision to enter into mediated sessions the VDC Hours of Work hearing scheduled for May 11, 2004 was cancelled.
