Re: BCGEU Access to @Work

This is to confirm that the Public Service Agency will provide a representative of the BCGEU with access to the @Work site. This access is being provided with the understanding that it is for viewing access only and the Union will not use the access to make posts on the site or contribute to conversations on @Work in any way.

The Public Service Agency is committed to monitoring the discussions on @Work to ensure that the terms of use guidelines are being followed and will edit posts when we determine that particular comments are inappropriate. As an employer-operated communications site, editorial content decisions and on whether or not to edit comments on the site are the sole discretion of the Agency.


Should the Union be of the view that there are any comments about the Union or representative(s) of the Union on the site that are in violation of the terms of use guidelines, please contact the Agency and we will look into the matter promptly. In the event that the parties are not in full agreement on the appropriateness of any such posts, the Agency will communicate the reasons for its decision to the Union.

Both parties will name a designate to deal with matters related to this letter.

The Agency will provide the Union with access to @Work effective the date the 18th Main Public Service Agreement is ratified and until the expiry of the 18th agreement, provided the Union does not violate the terms of its access indicated above.

This letter shall not form part of the ratification package for the 18th agreement and will not be published or promoted by either party in any way.
